Leave Your Baggage

A few years ago I had a training meeting in North Carolina. I left right after church one Sunday for a 2:30 flight out of Tampa. When I got to the check-in counter I was told I had 30 seconds before the flight closed out. I was really cutting it close! They also said that they would not guarantee the baggage I was checking would make it on to the flight. I was relieved to be on the plane and more relieved to look out the window and spot my baggage being loaded on the plane.

It is pretty amazing when every day millions of bags make it to their final destinations and are successfully retrieved by their owners. In the grand scheme, lost baggage is quite rare. 99.5% of all checked baggage is picked up by their owners, and of the ½ of 1% that does go missing, 95% of that baggage makes it home within 5 days.

There is the rare exception. Despite the exhaustive efforts of the airline some few bags remain unclaimed. That baggage goes to the Unclaimed Baggage Center. Yes, it's a real place where hopelessly lost baggage ends up. The Unclaimed Baggage Center purchases and unpacks your baggage, reselling each lost item on the shelves of its 50,000 square foot retail store.

In this Season of Lent, we can make a comparison between the literal baggage we carry while flying and the traveling we do with the

"baggage" of our burdens, brokenness, and sin – the baggage we carry as we crisscross through life and are called to reflect upon in the Season of Lent. Both the literal bags and the figurative baggage are with us largely through our own packing. Both are heavy and burdensome. Both are things that we tend to hold on to, afraid of how we'll make sense of life without the essentials inside. It is essential for us to understand the burden of these so-called essentials we bear.

Lent is God's invitation to drop your baggage into God's mercy and grace, where it is bought by someone else. That is what Jesus came to do. Jesus paid for that lost, unclaimed baggage – he paid a pretty high price for it too – so high that it will cover the cost of every sin-stuffed suitcase you want to bring. God in Jesus Christ gave his life in exchange for every single piece of baggage that's been breaking your back, your heart, and your spirit. Jesus is the one person who can own it, claim it, carry it, and not be crushed by it.

We are invited in Lent to take inventory of all that stuff you're carrying. Let's use this reflective season to bend our backs (and knees), to bow our hearts, and lift our spirits as we say to God in prayer, "I will not lug this around anymore. I will lose it. I will abandon it. I will give it to someone who can handle it." By the way, God accepts this baggage all year round, not just in the season of Lent.







What God Says About Himself






