## Living Every Day Like It's Easter Day

In the month of April, we continued our celebration of Easter Sunday as we explored the eye-witness accounts of those who encountered and were empowered by the presence of the risen Christ. John's Gospel shares two important encounters: In chapter 20, Thomas, who is best known for his doubting, actually shares one of the strongest statements of faith found in our Bible, "My Lord and my God." Also in chapter 20, you and I receive a blessing when Jesus says to Thomas, "You believe because you have seen me. Blessed are those who believe even though they have not seen."

In John chapter 21, our witnessed account comes as Peter and several of the disciples are still trying to process the events of the last few days. Here's the problem: These disciples are looking in the wrong place – they are looking in the tomb for a dead Jesus. And now the body is missing! They too soon discover the presence of the risen Christ as Jesus meets them at their point of need. If we are looking for Jesus, every day can be Easter Day.

Each of our four Gospel stories closes with an epilogue where the purpose of the story is restated in the conclusion. In each epilogue, Jesus calls his disciples to be witnesses and to live out their love for Jesus, now the risen Christ. The Gospel of John could have ended in Chapter 20 with Jesus' resurrection from the dead! It could have ended with Thomas' acclamation: "My Lord and my God!" Or, with the blessing you and I receive, "Blessed are those who believe without seeing."

But after the first Easter Sunday resurrection encounters with Christ, none of the gospels conclude with the resurrection. They all could have ended with Jesus rising from the grave, but they don't end there because Easter isn't over. They end with the risen Christ sending his disciples to take the message of God's love and grace and forgiveness into the world!

Being a disciple of Jesus Christ is something different than only loving Jesus – it is our becoming more like Christ; it is our being Christ for the world through our words and our actions that speak more powerfully than our words. As disciples of Jesus Christ, we are called to get in the boat <u>with</u> Jesus and then we are called to get out of the boat <u>for</u> Jesus.

Today, Jesus Christ is calling you and me to find new words and new ways to take God's unchanging message and to share it with a world that needs to hear and understand God's grace and love and forgiveness for themselves.


#### The Ortega Church Endowment Fund


#### Women's Bible Study - Mondays


