We've been experiencing grey, cloud-covered, stormy skies for days, for weeks! I was beginning to wonder if we should have made the Ark placed on the church playground more seaworthy! There were, however, some moments over the last few weeks when I have gone out at night to find a crystal-clear, star-lit night sky. There the words of Psalm 8 washed over me, and I asked, I prayed, "Who am I, Lord, that You should care for me?"

We just wrapped up our September Worship Series where we used the acrostic "I WILL" to explore God's interest and our church's initiatives to Invite, Welcome, Incorporate, Learn and Love. The Lord God of the universe has acquiesced to be revealed to us in creation, in Scripture, and in Jesus Christ, through the presence and the power of God's own Holy Spirit.

When we take moments to think of all this – under a star-lit night's sky or any other time and place along our journey of faith, these are the heightened moments of awareness when the Spirit of God calls to the human spirit to move deeper, wider, higher to acknowledge the Lord God's interest beyond some distant benevolent Being who is satisfied when we manage to fit God into our otherwise busy and event-filled lives in some small way.

"Surrendering our lives" to God is the language of our Bible. Surrendering to God is at the heart of people who live more fully into God's amazing invitation and welcome to be incorporated into God's mighty and boundless acts of salvation along a journey of faith with its endless learning opportunities to live in and to live out the limitless love of God. And from there we are encouraged to take **the next step** of being found even more fully in the presence of God.

Theologian R.C. Sproul shares, "We are never suitably touched and impressed with a conviction of our insignificance, until we have contrasted ourselves with the majesty of God." Perhaps this is the place where we should always begin our next step on our journey of faith – allowing ourselves to be suitably touched and humbly impressed with the conviction of our own insignificance by the majesty of God. The Lord God of the universe – who so wants to impress upon your mind and your heart that God is relentlessly in love with you.
