Join Ortega Church for a reverent and reflective Season of Lent exploring the "I AM" statements of Jesus found in the Gospel of John.

Sunday Worship: Each Sunday in Lent we will discover the meaning and intent of Jesus' message: I Am the Bread; I Am the Light; I Am the Door; I Am the Good Shepherd; I Am the Resurrection; I Am the Way, the Truth and the Life; and, I Am the Vine.

Daily Devotional: The purpose of the Season of Lent is to rededicate ourselves to reflect on who Jesus is and what Jesus has done for us as we use our P.R.A.I.S.E. method of listening to God: **P**ray, **R**ead scripture, **A**sk questions, Interpret and **S**ummarize what we are hearing so to be more Engaged by and with God.

Our daily devotionals will guide us through a reading of the Gospel of John. The Apostle John states his purpose for the book: "These words are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in His name" (John 20:31).

We pray your Lenten journey is a great blessing for you personally and for the community of faith who gathers together for God's Worship and the study of God's Holy Word. We hope to see you Sunday for Worship at Ortega Church!

On Friday, February 14, members of Ortega Church Missions Team flew into Santa Clara, Cuba. As we deplaned we were directed to "Controle de Pasaportes" (Passport Control). With passports and Visas in hand we queued up to be interviewed by Cuban authorities. Of course, the same will happen when we return to the United States. In both places we are asked, "Who are you?" and "What is your purpose here?" Basically, "Why are you here?"

These authorities are very serious. This is not a time for conversation, or quips, or humor – just answer the questions. But I was thinking, if I were to ask a question of the immigration officer, it might be, "Can I come here every morning and have you ask me the same question – 'Who are you and what is your purpose?"

I asked myself the same question as we began our descent over the Cuban countryside. With thoughts of all the busy things left undone at work and at home, why was I here at a place called "Placetas?" My thoughts became my prayer to God, "Why am I here?" The answer, "Because I need you here." Left to interpret the answer, I discerned God needing me in Placetas had less to do with what the missions team had come to give the people of Placetas and more of what gifts the mission to Placetas would bring to us.

On Saturday, we traveled to the new mission Iglesia de Placetas has planted in the poorest area of their city, known as Cumbre. There the pastor of Placetas asked, "Why are we here?" The same question generated the same answer, "Because I need you." There are gifts Placetas will share with Cumbre – the people of Cumbre need the people of Placetas to show the love of Christ in a place no other church has dared to serve.

In my Sunday morning greeting, I encouraged the people of Placetas to be prepared to also receive gifts from their mission, as I was from my mission with them. I shared that I was less their missionary than they were mine. I thanked the people of Placetas for being my missionaries, for showing me the love Christ as they served "the least of these" in Placetas and in Cumbre. I asked, "Why am I here?" And I told the people of Placetas... "Because I need you." I Invite each of you to allow God to ask you the same questions: "Why are you here... and what is your purpose?"




