Holy Week Observances and Easter Sunday Worship Share the "I Am" Proclamations of Jesus Christ

"I am the Resurrection and the Life" is the fifth of the seven "I am" statements Jesus shares in the Gospel of John. It offers a godly perspective on several spiritual matters: Martha believes the resurrection is an event; Jesus shows us the resurrection is a Person. Martha's knowledge of eternal life was an abstract idea; Jesus teaches eternal life is a personal relationship. Martha thinks victory over death is a future expectation; Jesus corrects her, showing that victory is a present reality. Jesus asks Martha an all-important question: "Do you believe this?" May Martha's answer be ours: "Yes, Lord, I believe you are the Christ, the Son of God, the one who has come into the world from God."

PASTOR'S POST by Rev. Art McClellan

On a Walk to the Village (The Methodist Children's Village)



I suppose at this time of year, with Easter fast approaching, some would quickly discern "On a walk to the village" to be the resurrection account found in Luke 24: On the same day (of Jesus' resurrection), two of Jesus' followers were walking to the village of Emmaus, seven miles from Jerusalem. As they walked along, they were talking about everything that had happened. As they talked and discussed these things, Jesus himself suddenly came and began walking with them. But God kept them from recognizing him. (Luke 24:13-16)

Picking up in verse 30, As they sat down to eat, Jesus took the bread and blessed it. Then Jesus broke it and gave it to them. Suddenly, their eyes were opened, and they recognized him. (Luke 24: 30-31)

I recently recognized Jesus on a walk to the Village – The Methodist Children's Village. I actually drove the seven-mile journey early that Saturday morning. A small team of volunteers joined to take on the task to rebuild

the deteriorating 47-foot entry ramp to the Toddler Classroom Building. Last year Ortega Church shared our Easter Offering to upgrade the building – a new roof and a fresh coat of paint have certainly increased the street appeal and life expectancy. Your financial gifts also covered the material cost for replacing the deck. Ortega Church volunteers help stretch those dollars to meet other needs.

Being part of this one day "hands and feet of Jesus" outreach is a little tiring on my worn body, but oh so refreshing to my soul. Good Christian company and good work lifts the spirit. After our Phase 2 building day – yes, there will be a third workday if your are interested – I began my walk at the village. It came to my mind and spirit that the MCV board, and Director and Staff also serve as the hands and feet of Jesus five days a week, 7am - 6pm, sharing their gifts for ministry with the least of these – children of working families who are trying to make ends meet.

As I walked, I notice the thriftiness of this barebones operation. I picked up a classroom broom that looked more like a porcupine to sweep up the remnants of our day's work. More observations noticed that many of the classroom supplies are tired and worn (like I was feeling:-) and need refreshing. Our Missions Team will soon encourage your support for the 2025 Easter Offering: A shopping list to refresh MCV's spirit ... and ours. We pray you will share the resurrection spirit that is ours at Easter and always in this small outreach to the least of these.
