

In our recent Lenten Worship
Series we explored the seven "I Am"
statements Jesus declared for himself
and his unique connection to God
the Father. We closed the series with
Jesus' "I am the true vine" (John 15:114). We read, "I am the true vine, and
my Father is the gardener. He cuts
off every branch of mine that doesn't
produce fruit, and he prunes the
branches that do bear fruit so they will
produce even more."

One Saturday each month over the past few months, I have been attempting to reclaim the grape arbor that once produced great amounts of fruit at our family farm. Over the past few years, the vineyard fell into neglect. The vines have run all over the place, even up in the nearby pecan trees, and the thorny bamboo vines have grown among the grape vines. The weight of all the extra growth caused the trellises to collapse. For years the vineyard has not been pruned – it was just one big fruitless mess.



So, I took out the lop-shears, the pruning shears and even a chainsaw and I got all dirty and beat up and bloody to cut the branches from the vine. With chain and tractor I separated the fruitless branches from the vine and dragged it all into a

huge burn pile. A new trellis is now built and moving forward it will take time and attention to cultivate the new branches connected to the vine – properly prune and prop so they will produce even more fruit.

It's important to remember that in Jesus' illustration he isn't speaking about people who don't believe in God! Jesus is talking to believers when he speaks about branches that are already on the vine but who are not producing fruit. People who confess Jesus with their lips but who do not produce fruit with their lives. People who say they believe, but who don't allow themselves to be pruned for their own righteousness and for making disciples.

Jesus is speaking about a faith that produces actions and good works. Our faith in Jesus Christ is what saves us. Our knowing this fact should be evident by the fruit of our lives – evidence that our soul has been saved, and our spirit is connected to the Spirit of Christ. If we have faith in Jesus Christ there really should be fruit of our faith. The passage closes with Jesus sharing, "This is to my Father's glory, that you bear much fruit, showing yourselves to be my disciples."
