In Acts chapter 1, Jesus tells his disciples, "You will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you. And you will be my witnesses, telling people about me everywhere in Jerusalem, throughout Judea, in Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." Following Jesus' ascension into heaven, the apostles returned to Jerusalem and to the upstairs room of the house where they were staying. They all met together and were constantly devoting themselves to prayer as they wait for the Pentecost event. From the moment the Holy Spirit is poured over and into them, the expanding nature of the mission Jesus calls them begins:

Jerusalem – Their immediate community – where they are and where they are most comfortable, surrounded by people who speak the same language, and who share the same culture.

Judea – Still familiar territory but now the beginning of carrying the message more outwardly, including places and people where we may be less comfortable or even challenged in our faith.

Samaria – Representing the cultural and religious divide the disciples have to overcome. These are places and people whom Jesus's followers would rather not be, but are called to serve anyway.

The Ends of the Earth – This is the global call to reach all nations,

every tribe and tongue, taking these disciples well beyond their familiar surroundings, past their borders and comfort to places they could not even imagine.

The mission of Jesus' Great Commission is always ever-expanding. It starts where we are but doesn't stay there. It grows, it stretches, it moves to carry the *Good News* to every corner of the world. Here's a question for us: How big is your world?

It Starts at Home with Gary Thomas

Who is shaping what your kids believe?

In these busy, hectic days we take our kids to sports practices, games, music lessons, school tutoring, and other activities to give our children the best opportunities for success. But what if we're missing the chance to teach them what matters most?

Our children can grow up smart, athletic, popular, and polite but lack a vibrant relationship with Christ. The few hours they spend in church each week can be helpful, but it cannot nurture a faith in our kids that will withstand the trials that are on the horizon. Church alone cannot teach them, we must start at home. But many parents feel ill-equipped to develop the faith of their children.

In these six sessions, we will explore biblical and tangible ways that parents—couples, single parents, blended families, and grandparents—can build a legacy of faith for their children.

VOLUNTEER SPOTLIGHT Phillip Bancroft


