Summer is a season many of us look forward to all year for things like going to the beach, going on vacation, spending time outside in nature, taking trips to see family, or hosting family coming to visit us. Summer is also a season of life we enjoy – a season of creation when things are new and fresh and growing – when we say "Life is good!"

The challenging thing about the summer season of life for many of us on our faith journey is that it is easy to often overlook God in the good times. In the winter seasons of life – in seasons of trial, it can be more obvious that we need God – God's love, God's grace, God's guidance.

When we start to come out of the winters and into the springs of life, we get this feeling of relief, we thank God for creatively bringing us into this new, fresh, growing season.

Psalm 139 speaks of rejoicing in the joy of life and the new life of finding and abiding in God – the springs that leads into the summer seasons of life.

Psalm 139:1-24 paints a beautiful picture of God and God's attributes. If we're going to stay mindful of and recognize God during the good times, during the summers of our life, then starting with the attributes of God is one of the best ways we can abide with God. Psalm 139 is not an exhaustive list by any means, but it is a truly wonderful depiction of who God is, nonetheless.

In Worship on Sunday, July 27, I shared a few of the attributes outlined in this Psalm to share three Assurances we can come to know and rejoice over in all seasons of life: God Knows Me Intimately – "O Lord, you have searched me and known me! You know when I sit down and when I rise up; you discern my thoughts from afar. You search out my path and my lying down and are acquainted with all my ways." – Psalm 139:1-3

God is with Me Constantly – "Where shall I go from your Spirit? Or where shall I flee from your presence? If I ascend to heaven, you are there! If I make my bed in Sheol, you are there! If I take the wings of the morning and dwell in the uttermost parts of the sea, even there your hand shall lead me, and your right hand shall hold me. – Psalm 139:7-10

God Made Me Wonderfully – "For you formed my inward parts; you knitted me together in my mother's womb. I praise you, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made. Wonderful are your works; my soul knows it very well. How precious to me are your thoughts, O God! How vast is the sum of them! If I would count them, they are more than the sand. I awake, and I am still with you." – Psalm 139:13-14;17-18

In light of the fact that God knows me, God is with me, and God made me, may we join the psalmist to close the passage saying, "Search me, O God, and know my heart; test me and know my anxious thoughts. Point out anything in me that offends you, and lead me along the path of everlasting life. – Psalm 139:23-24



THE ART OF NEIGHBORING with DAVE RUNYON & JAY PATHAK

What comes to mind when you think about your neighbors? Maybe you don't know them very well or, if you're honest, maybe you think the lady across the street is a bit weird. For many of us, it can be tempting to keep our distance and mind our own business in our neighborhood. But is that really how God wants us to live?

As followers of Jesus, we've been called to love both God and our neighbors. It's easier said than done, but if we push past the fear, time barriers, and pride that can keep us from engaging with others, we can build deep connections with the people in our neighborhood and, most importantly, please God.

In this four-session series based on their book The Art of Neighboring, Jay Pathak and Dave Runyon help us focus on the people within our neighborhood and learn what it means to be a good neighbor. They discuss the importance of pushing through the uncomfortable feelings that come with communicating, investing in, and caring for the people who live near us. What would our communities look like if we took Jesus's command to love our neighbors as ourselves seriously?


