
OPEN THE DOOR TO LOVE AND **SERVE OTHERS** with Logan Wolfram

TERRY SCHOLARSHIP FUND

Ortega Methodist Church Endowment Funds



For 25 years The Terry Scholarship Fund has gifted students with financial assistance toward their higher education pursuits, both at the graduate and undergraduate level. The Fund's benefactor Mary Virginia Terry's original purpose was to encourage those hearing a call to ordained ministry or to vocations in Christian service. The Board of the Endowment Fund and the Leadership of Ortega Church recently clarified the benefactor's original intent and is recasting the vision for qualifying candidates to receive scholarships from the Fund.

Currently, Asbury Theological Seminary plays a pivotal role in strengthening the Global Methodist Church (GMC) by equipping future pastors through scholarship support. Asbury recently received a \$1 million matching opportunity for donations directed to GMC scholarships. These scholarships will help fill pulpits with well-trained, theologically grounded, and missionally committed pastors at a time when the denomination is establishing its identity and momentum.

Through this partnership, Ortega Church has recommended that students receiving The Terry Scholarship are anticipated to serve the Florida Conference of the Global Methodist Church. The Terry Scholarship Fund is one of five endowed giving focuses of Ortega Church, including The Permanent Endowment Fund.
